# TravelTales 3.5

- New stuff in this release:
  - TravelTales for Android based devices
    - Added possibility to share on Facebook
    - Small UI updates
    - Now using journey name from the TravelTales Server instead of the name of the journey config file
    - Added robustness when handling a faulty journey config file

# TravelTales 3.5

- Legacy contents in this release:
  - Common for Android and iOS based devices
    - GPS based activation of sound files (.mp3)
    - Configurable accuracy: 5 meters – 200 meters
    - Easy management by xml based configuration files
    - Several journeys (packages) can be carried along simultaneously
    - Local database storage
    - Automatic language selection
      - English and Danish currently supported
    - Volume control
    - Remote journey download from TravelTales servers
    - Local journey selector
    - Optional handset vibration when activating a sound file
    - Sound test capability

# TravelTales 3.5

- Easy handling of licensing
  - Features to support Orienteering; Travel-O
  - UI aligned with findveji.dk
  - Map view for current location
  - Map view for points of interest
  
  - iOS specifics:
    - Supports iOS 6.0 and newer
    - Available in the App Store
  
  - Android specifics:
    - Supports Android 2.2 and newer
    - Available at Google Play
- Online TravelTales configuration tool
- The tool can be used to create a journey for TravelTales

# TravelTales 3.5

- The tool will output a zip-file ready to be placed on the TravelTales server
  
- J2ME / Symbian specifics:
  - Supports MIDP2.0 and newer
  - Supports Symbian OS 9.2 and newer
  - Code signed by Thawte valid until 15<sup>th</sup> of July 2013
  - R2.2 is available for download at [www.TravelTales.dk](http://www.TravelTales.dk)
  - J2ME / Symbian handsets are not official supported anymore.
  - Some handsets will still work – test the handset before using it in an event.
